INGREDIENTS SELECTED FROM: Oats, Barley, Maize, DDG, Salt, Chaff, Bran, Copra, Molasses, Vegetable oil, Calcium, Vitamins & Minerals.
CAUTION: Contains Selenium 0.3mg/kg feed. Do not exceed the stated dose and frequency. Do not use at the same time as any other selenised fertiliser, prill or product without consulting a veterinarian.

FEEDING RECOMMENDATIONS: SUPA SHINE is a basic supplementary feed for non working and spelling race, eventing and pleasure horses. This meal should be fed in limited quantities with adlib pasture, hay and/or chaff. The actual level fed is dependant on the condition of the horse and the quality and mix of the roughage sources.

As a guideline, feed 1-2kg/day SUPA SHINE to a mature 500kg adult. If body condition is poor this may be raised to 3-4kg/day until condition is regained. If the horse carries excessive condition reduce the meal intake to 0.5 to 1kg/day. When offering higher amounts split the daily meal into morning and evening feeds to avoid acidosis and improve the efficiency of meal utilization. Mixing the meal with chaff will reduce the rate of meal intake and help minimize digestive upsets.

As SUPA SHINE contains a full range of minerals and vitamins and resting horses have low nutrient requirements no other dietary supplementation is required. Offer fresh feed daily and discard uneaten feed as this may be a source of mould growth which will reduce palatability and promote mycotoxin contamination of fresh feed and feeding containers. Ensure fresh clean drinking water is available at all times.
