**CAUTION:** Contains Selenium 0.3mg/kg feed. Do not exceed the stated dose and frequency. Do not use at the same time as any other selenised fertiliser, prill or product without consulting a veterinarian.

**FEEDING RECOMMENDATIONS:** SUPA TRACK is a supplementary feed for in work racing, eventing and pleasure horses. This meal should be fed along with adlib pasture, good hay and/or chaff. The actual level fed is dependent on the condition of the horse and level and frequency of exercise. As a guideline, feed 3-6kg/-day SUPA TRACK to a mature horse of around 500kg. Typically, eventing horses in good condition will require 3-4kg/day and racehorses 5-6+kg/day during periods of intense competition or racing. When offering higher amounts split the daily meal allocation into at least 2 and preferably 3 feeds throughout the day to avoid acidosis and improve the efficiency of meal utilization. Mixing the meal with chaff will reduce the rate of meal intake and help minimize digestive upsets.

The proportion of roughage components in the diet (pasture, hay, chaff) should never fall below 40% of the daily dry matter intake. This minimum level will normally only apply to race horses during intensive periods of racing. Eventing horses will rarely need to fall below 50% roughage in the daily dry matter intake. As SUPA TRACK contains a full range of major minerals, trace minerals and vitamins no other dietary supplementation is required. Offer fresh feed daily and discard uneaten feed as this may be a source of mould growth which will reduce palatability and promote mycotoxin contamination of fresh feed and feeding containers. Ensure fresh clean drinking water is available at all times.
